Class Descriptions:

Monday

_____ Upcycled Collage ~ Gr. K-1 ~ Instructor: Mia Bogya (4 Weeks) We will create using a variety of clippings, cards, ribbons, fabric scraps, frames and so much more as we study artists that use collage in their artwork.

_____ Musical Storytelling ~ Gr. K-1 ~ Instructor: Melody Hasbrouck (4 weeks)

Everyone loves a good story. But how can you tell a story without words? We'll explore the world of sound, how it makes us feel, and how we can shape our music to communicate with others.

_____ Destroy This Book ~ Gr. 2-5 ~ Instructor: Noreen Torelli Our goal will be to explore different media in order to transform our books into a piece of art!

_____ Lyrical Songwriting ~ Gr. 3-5 ~ Instructor: Laurel Jordan

Do you love to sing? Have you always wanted to write your own song? We will learn how to write a song; including the parts of a song, writing lyrics and adding a melody.

_____ Minecraft? Minecraft! ~ Gr. 4-5 ~ Instructor: Peter Rimkunas What if the Community Arts Center was in Minecraft? What would it look like? What would you do there? We are going to find out by making the most extreme Arts Center in the ENTIRE universe!

Tuesday

_____ Make Your Own Superhero ~ Gr. K-1 ~ Instructor: Bernie Tajonera Using fun activities, their super imagination, students will create their own superheroes while designing their own lapbook.

_____ In the Mudroom ~ Gr. K-1 ~ Instructor: Amy Valentine We will have the opportunity to use the pottery wheel as well as with handbuilding to create vessels and clay sculptures.

_____ Drawing and Digital Animation ~ Gr. 2-5 ~ Instructor: Noreen Torelli Make your drawings walk and move in this introductory course in digital animation.

_____ Batik ~ Gr. 2-5 ~ Instructor: Lynn MacDonald We will create original works of art using ink and a wax resist technique on fabric.

Wednesday (Classes are still held on early release Wednesdays.)

_____ Recycle Imagination ~ Gr. K-1 ~ Instructor: Lynn MacDonald The sky's the limit! We will create a variety of projects using recycled materials.

_____ Zoology ~ Gr. K-1 ~ Instructor: Noreen Torelli Each week we will learn about a new animal and make a miniature habitat or a piece of artwork representing it.

_____ Minecraft? Minecraft! ~ (Group B) Gr. 2-3 ~ Instructor: Peter Rimkunas What if the Community Arts Center was in Minecraft? What would it look like? What would you do there? We are going to find out by making the most extreme Arts Center in the ENTIRE universe!

_____ Guitar & Instrumental Songwriting ~ Gr. 2-5 ~ Instructor: Bernie Tajonera In this introduction to guitar, we will learn basic techniques and chords in order to create their own songs.

_____ Stained Glass & Mosaics ~ Gr. 4-5 ~ Instructor: Deb Harmon We will learn to use the tools and techniques associated with making stained glass and creating mosaics to create one of kind artwork.

_____ Simple Science ~ Gr. K-1 ~ Instructor: Bernie Tajonera (4 weeks) We will concoct and create in this introduction to science and STEM activities.

_____ Paper Art ~ Gr. K-1 ~ Instructor: Hannah Manning (4 weeks) We will use a variety of techniques in order to create winter themed artwork.

_____ In the Mudroom ~ Gr. 2-5 ~ Instructor: Christina Thibault We will have the opportunity to hone their skills on the wheel as well as with handbuilding to create vessels and clay sculptures.

_____ Aboriginal Art ~ Gr. 2-5 ~ Instructor: Lynn MacDonald We will explore other cultures while creating items like masks, rain sticks and aboriginal paintings.

Friday

_____ Free Form Friday ~ Gr. K-1 ~ Instructor: Hannah Manning A winter themed collection of projects that will include drawing, painting and constructing.

_____ Upcycling ~ Gr. 2-5 ~ Instructor: Lynn MacDonald Bring something old back to life! Students will transform old furniture or other pieces in new and improved art objects.

_____ Reality Made Virtual ~ Gr. 2-5 ~ Instructor: Peter Rimkunas

Do you like animals, Pokemon and adventure? In class, we will be making a "monster" collecting game in the style of Pokemon with clay, cardboard and drawings that will be converted into a playable computer game via 3D scanning!
